Additional prerequisites for consideration include a high school diploma or equivalent, a valid WA State drivers' license, and candidates must be at least 18 years of age.

Job Description

The primary responsibility of a Groundman is to support the work of the Journeyman Lineman and the Apprentice Lineman by performing assigned tasks.

Qualifications

- Applicant must meet residency requirements
- Must be able to pass a criminal background check and drug screening
- Must possess or obtain a valid Class A CDL and required medical card within six months from the date of employment
- Must be physically fit to perform such duties as lifting 75 pounds, digging holes, assist in setting poles and anchors, maintenance on tools, trucks, and work equipment, moving materials, helping load and unload poles, using chain saws and other tree-cutting and clearing equipment, using chemical spray equipment for right-of-way care, learning how to use all required hand tools on the ground in connection with line construction, and be comfortable with heights
- Must attend safety meetings and other classroom training provided by the Cooperative
- Must possess a positive attitude, a desire to be of service in all areas covered by the position, and a willingness to work overtime

Education/Experience Required/Preferred

- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- Successful completion of an accredited Lineman pre-apprenticeship program
